Accommodation

At Osprey Hotel, our deep commitment to the environment drives us to transform into a more sustainable hotel. Through various initiatives, we've made impactful changes that help us maintain a low carbon footprint, minimise waste, and closely monitor our energy consumption—all while ensuring our guests continue to receive a great quality service.

We close windows when heating/ AC is on.
We use a Combined Heat and Power unit to increase energy efficiency.

All our energy is obtained from renewable sources.

We include recycling bins in our guest rooms.

We offer linen/towel change on request.

We have targets in place for our energy, waste and water consumption.

Corridors have motion sensors that turn off lights when not in use.

All lights in the Hotel have been replaced with LED.

We use biodegradable and non-toxic cleaning products.

Bedrooms and meeting rooms use glass water bottles, not plastic.

Catering

- Our coffee and tea, as well as many foods are Fairtrade.
- We use reusable water jugs/bottles.
- We prioritise sourcing from local suppliers offering seasonal, and organic products.
- Additionally, we mandate that all our suppliers maintain a sustainability policy.
- Healthy break options available (fruit skewers, smoothies and others).
- Food leftovers offered to meting guests (at the end of events).
- We avoid the use of disposable items such as cups, plates and tableware.
- We offer vegetarian and vegan options promoting more plant-based products.
- Recycling is taken seriously: cardboard, plastic, glass, and food bins used to ensure that materials are being properly recycled.



Hybrid Meetings

- Osprey Ballroom can be professionally set up so that your available team members can meet, while those unavailable to attend in person can join virtually, in a more professional setting.
- Osprey Hotel stage can be set with customised backdrops incorporating your company logo, digital screens can be used to bring in virtual guests.
- With a full team of audio-visual technicians, professional lighting, cameras, and sound capabilities, your online event will be smooth, professional, and impressive, allowing for more interaction amongst the onsite team, whilst presenting professionally to the virtual team.


We use natural daylight as much as possible and encourage clients to follow suit.




Minimise literature and delegate packs.

Entertainment and Activities




We suggest visits to local attractions to give delegates an appreciation of the local environment and culture.
